Delegate Elections

The Florida Democratic Party will select delegates based on Congressional Districts to represent Florida as we nominate Joe Biden and Kamala Harris for re-election. Sarasota County is part of Congressional District 17, which includes Sarasota and Charlotte Counties and a small portion of Lee County. The Convention will be held in Chicago from August 19 to 22.

For District-Level Delegate positions, CD17 will elect three men and two women. Voting takes place on April 18th & 20th. Any registered Democrat in CD17 can vote.
